Marriage is God's plan for the good of men and women. Also, it is God's plan for the home to be a place for the home to be a place of love and security for children. Marriage will not work when it is abused. Marriage can be beautiful only when:

1. Husband and wife follow God's purpose for marriage. It was "not good for man to be alone," so God provided a companion. (Gen 2:18). This was God's way of multiplying and replenishing the earth. ((Gen 1:28). It was also intended to prevent immorality ( 1 Cor 7:2), and to provide a place of service in the home for woman (1 Tim 5:13f). Marriage cannot be beautiful when these purposes of God are ignored or forgotten.
2. Husband and wife follow God's moral principles. (1 Cor 6:13-20). It is not possible for a marriage to flourish without trust. How can either party trust the other to be true to the marriage vow if the other holds and practices moral views destructive to their relationship? It is natural for a loyal wife to resent and repudiate a philandering husband. It is natural for a loyal husband to turn away from a wife who is not willing to be a companion to him, but who seeks companionship from a third party.

Marriage can be and should be beautiful!

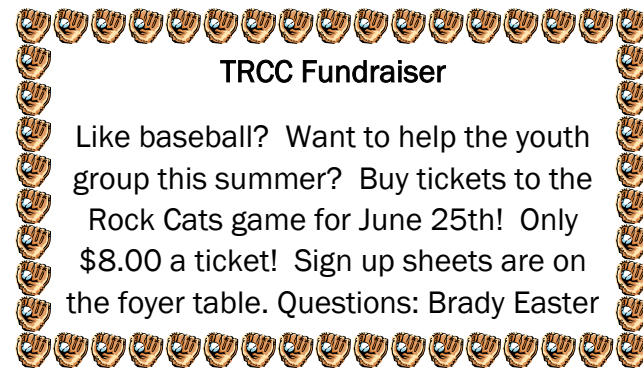

## ANTHONY'S CORNER

Perfection! Whether we are talking about a major league pitcher retiring 27 batters in a row, a bowler going for a 300 game or a softball team that was hoping to experience a whole season without any defeats, perfection is something that is often quite elusive. But then when we talk about perfection in reference to living a life in which a mistake is never made nor is a sin ever committed, the whole thing is taken to a level that no one (except for the Lord) has ever achieved. As we present the gospel to those who need to hear, this concept of perfection often comes up. We may refer to scriptures such as Romans 3:23, "**For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God**" in order to get the point across that none of us is perfect. Scriptures such as I Corinthians 10:13, "**No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it**" serve to convict us of our sinful imperfection because we know that we don't always take advantage of that way of escape offered by God when we are tempted. It would be nice to be perfect, especially as it relates to our everyday doings. In order to achieve this elusive, unachievable state, we must go to the One who is perfect, that is Jesus. When we entrust our lives to Him and remain faithful, we become perfect with a perfection whose original owner is not us, but Jesus. In other words, Jesus "deals us in" where perfection is concerned by giving His righteousness to us to the point where we become the righteousness of God in Christ (see II Corinthians 5:21). The good news is that we can be regarded as perfect in the sight of God as long as we remain faithful to the Christ who loved us enough to pay for our sins on the cross. That's the kind of perfection we really want.
